**Study Aid for the Sermon from April 2, 2017
Old Testament Examples of Saving Faith
Hebrews 11:23-31**

Observing the text

What did the faith of Moses' parents overcome when they hid baby Moses (Hebrews 11:23 cf. Exodus 2:1-2:2)?

What did the faith of Moses overcome when he identified with God's people rather than the house of Pharaoh (Hebrews 11:24-26 cf. 2:3-2:10)?

What did the faith of Moses overcome when he chose to leave Egypt (Hebrews 11:27 cf. 2:11-15), 3:1-20?

What did the faith of Moses overcome when he kept the Passover (Hebrews 11:28 cf. Exodus 12:1-28)?

What did the faith of God's people overcome when they chose to pass through the Red Sea (Hebrews 11:29 cf. Exodus 14:5-14)?

What did the faith of God's people overcome when they marched around the walls of Jericho (Hebrews 11:30 cf. Joshua 6:1-21)?

What did the faith of Rahab overcome when she welcomed the spies (Hebrews 11:31 cf. Joshua 2:1-21, 6:25)?

Applying the sermon

What are the most difficult and challenging areas of your life at this present time?

Based upon God's word, how do you believe that God would have you to respond to these various difficulties and challenges?

Do you believe that you are presently responding to these difficulties and challenges in the way that God would have you respond?

If you believe that you are not responding in the way that you believe God would have you to respond, will you now as an expression of your faith in God and through the grace that He will supply, give to Him what He is asking for from you?

If you do give God what He is asking for from you, even though it may be difficult, do you believe that it will testify to the genuineness of your faith and the certainty of your future reward?
