Awana Ministry

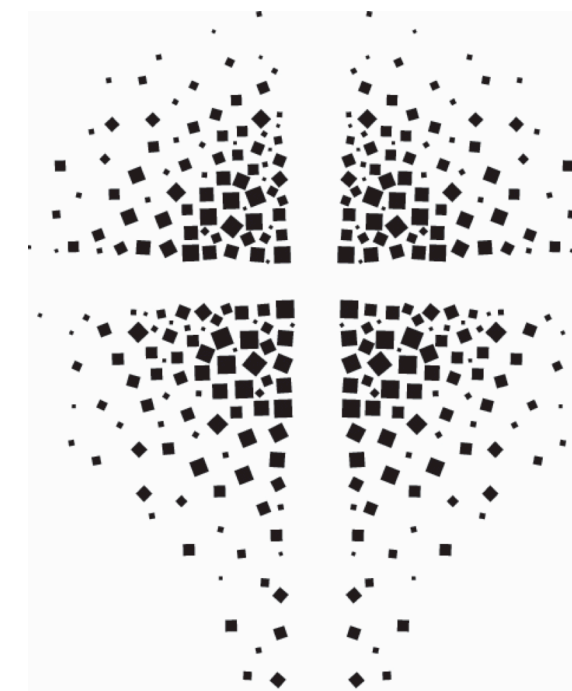

CPR Classes

We are offering CPR certification classes here at VBC most Saturdays and some Mondays starting in October. These classes will be taught by Matt Critchfield, a certified CPR instructor, and will cover Adult/Child/Infant CPR/AED use as well as how to respond to choking adults/children/infants. Early intervention and providing immediate CPR and AED to a person suffering a sudden cardiac arrest has been proven to greatly increase their chances of survival. Our goal is to equip our ministry workers in lifesaving measures and reach out to our community through this training.
