John 14:1, 6, 21, 27

Jesus said, "Believe also in Me," in verse 1. What did he want us to believe about Him (verse 6)?

What are typical issues about which your heart may be troubled? How would believing in Jesus (per verse 6) result in not having a troubled heart?

What actions follow in the life of a person believing in Jesus (verse 21)?

Do you believe in Jesus in a manner which results in a general life pattern of obedience? What evidence is there?

What specific things does the Father do for those who believe in Jesus (verses 1,21)? What does Jesus do (verse 21)?

When you do your part in your relationship with God, in what specific ways might the items in verse 27 be produced (peace unlike any other, a non-troubled heart, a non-fearful heart)?

Will you believe in Jesus as is described in verse 6? Will you commit yourself to acting according to such a faith? Tell the Lord what is in your heart.
