Observing the text

Were those living under the Mosaic Law ever free from the consciousness of sin (Hebrews 10:1)?

How did the Mosaic Law perpetuate the consciousness of sin (Hebrews 10:2-4)?

What did Christ do in order to solve this consciousness of sin problem (Hebrew 10:5-9)?

If a person by faith takes advantage of what Christ has done for them on their behalf and their consciousness of sin problem has been solved, does this mean that they will, from that day forward, be blissfully unaware of their sinfulness?
